

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
TUESDAY, AUGUST 11, 1970

The regular meeting of the board of commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on August 11, 1970. The following members of the board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Commissioners Robert B. Jones and Woodrow Price. Also present for the meeting was Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney.

Mayor J. Paul Wilson called the meeting to order and the clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were approved as written.

Mayor Wilson welcomed Mr. C. Roy Smith, Mr. Marrow and Mr. Carrado, citizens of the Town of Lake Lure.

Mr. C. Roy Smith reported to the board that water skiing was being done in a reckless manner in the Tryon Bay area of Lake Lure and that on some occasions boats containing as many as twelve children were pulling skiers. He also stated that in his opinion high powered boats are a hazard on the lake and should be banned.

Mr. Smith also reported that water lilies are rapidly taking over certain areas of the lake and requested that the board have the lilies sprayed and suggested that the Wildlife Commission be consulted as to the best type of spray to use.

Mr. Smith also suggested that the Board take action to improve fishing in the Lake and that rearing pools for fish to be used for stocking the lake be constructed.

Mr. Wilson advised Mr. Smith that he would consult the Wildlife Commission as to the best spray to be used on the lilies and that the other suggestions of Mr. Smith would be taken under advisement by the board.

Mr. Carrado expressed his appreciation to the board for the much needed improvements that had been made on the road in his neighborhood.

Mr. Marrow stated to the board that he felt the Town of Lake Lure should be zoned.

Mayor Wilson advised the board of the receipt by him of a letter from the Federal Power Commission advising that certain errors had been discovered on the original tracings of the Lake Lure Dam which were submitted to the said Federal Power Commission by the Town of Lake Lure as a part of its application for a license to operate the Lake Lure Electric Power Plant and that the staff of the Federal Power Commission would make the needed corrections upon receipt of additional information from the Town of Lake Lure and upon receipt of authority from the board of commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure to make said corrections. Mayor Wilson also advised the board that the information necessary to make the needed corrections had already been forwarded to the Federal Power Commission.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Price, and unanimously passed Mayor Wilson was authorized and directed to write a letter to the Federal Power Commission authorizing the staff of said Commission to make the needed corrections on the original tracings.

Upon motion of Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Jones, and unanimously passed, the board voted to pay the electric power bill for the residence occupied by Emery Searcy, the operator of the Lake Lure Electric Power Facility.

Upon motion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Price, and unanimously passed, the board approved the payment of the remainder of the legal fee of the Lake Lure Sewage Disposal Plant in the amount of \$1350.00 to Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Attorney at Law.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:00 o'clock P. M.
