MONDAY, AUGUST 24, 1970


A special meeting of the board of commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 10:00 A. M. on the 24th day of August, 1970, pursuant to waiver of notice.

The Mayor, J. Paul Wilson, called the meeting to order and the clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were approved as written.


Mayor Wilson announced that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss adjustments of wages and salaries of certain employees of the Town of Lake Lure.

After discussion, Commissioner Jones moved, seconded by Mayor Wilson, that increases retroactive to July 1, 1970 be made in the wages and salaries of certain employees of the Town of Lake Lure as follows:

Devault Edgerton increased to \$80.00 per week;
Arthur Lawter increased to \$90.00 per week;
Ray Vess increased to \$90.00 per week;
Blanche B. Liles, Clerk, increased to \$420.00 per month;
W. L. Pye, Police, increased to \$420.00 per month.

The motion unanimously passed.
