MONDAY, MARCH 20, 1972


A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 P. M. on the 20th day of March, 1972, pursuant to the waiver of notice.

The following members of the board were present: Mayor J. Paul Wilson; Commissioner Avery T. Cashion, Jr. and Commissioner Zeb V. Dalton.


The meeting was held after waiver of notice as follows:

The Mayor, J. Paul Wilson, called the meeting to order and the minutes of the last meeting were read. The minutes were approved as written.

The Mayor called the attention of the other board members to a map which had been submitted to the engineer of the Town of Lake Lure showing the location of certain roads being constructed by First Development Corporation of America within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure and on property of the said First Development Corporation known as Golf Estates, Section 1 of "The Mountains" and advised the board that the said First Development Corporation of America has requested the Town of Lake Lure to accept the roads shown on said map and within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure for maintenance when such roads are completed by the said First Development Corporation of America to the design engineering standards which conform to N. C. State Highway Commission Secondary Road specifications and will qualify for Powell Bill funds.

After discussion, Commissioner Dalton moved that the Town of Lake Lure accept for maintenance the roads shown on the map hereinbefore mentioned and lying within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure at such time as said roads are completed by the First Development Corporation of America to the design engineering standards which conform to N. C. State Highway Commission Secondary Road specifications and will qualify for Powell Bill funds.

This motion was unanimously passed.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned 'at 8:00 P. M.
