

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
TUESDAY, MAY 9, 1972

The regular meeting of the board of commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on May 9, 1972. The following members of the board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor and Zeb V. Dalton, Commissioner. Avery T. Cashion, Jr., Commissioner was absent. Hollis M. Owens, Jr. Town Attorney was present.

Mayor J. Paul Wilson presided and called the meeting to order. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as written.

Mr. W. H. Dodd, a member of the Lake Lure Golf Club suggested to the board that Golf Club Green Fees be increased to \$3.00 per day for Mondays through Fridays and to \$4.00 per day for Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. The Board agreed to consider this suggestion.

Mrs. Louis Bartruff complained to the board about the maintenance of Ridgeview Road and asked the board to keep it in better condition. She also thanked the board for the good job done by Chief of Police Gene L. Lovell in looking after property while she and Mr. Bartruff were away.

Mayor Wilson declared the meeting to be in recess until 8:30 o'clock P. M. in order to make the Town Hall available for the Chimney Rock No. 2 precinct meeting, after which the meeting of the board of commissioners resumed.


Mr. Jim Nance requested the board to have speed limit signs erected on U. S. Highway No. 74 between Cane Creek Bridge and the Town of Lake Lure Business area. He also advised that school bus signs should be placed along the highway in the same area.

Mr. Richard Washburn reported to the board regarding safety buoys needed on the lake known as Lake Lure.

Upon motion of Commissioner Dalton, seconded by Mayor Wilson and unanimously adopted the board voted to purchase and to cause to be placed on the lake known as Lake Lure, buoys as follows: 2 NO WAKE Buoys, 2 RED Buoys, 2 BLACK buoys in the main channel; 2 BOATS KEEP OUT Buoys at the dam; 1 NO WAKE Buoy in Sunset Cove; 1 NO WAKE Buoy in Boulder Cove; 1 NO WAKE Buoy in Snug Harbor; 2 NO WAKE Buoys in Cane Creek Cove.

Mr. Larry R. Phillips protested to the board the 12:00 o'clock midnight closing of dance halls in Lake Lure. He advised that since daylight savings time has become effective the 12:00 o'clock midnight closing deadline cuts one hour from the time he can operate his dance hall. He requested that he be allowed to keep his dance hall open until 12:30 o'clock P. M. He also stated that the ordinance of the Town of Lake Lure regulating dance halls is illegal and that if he had to he would contest said ordinance in court.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 9:30 o'clock P. M.
