

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 1972

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 p. m. on September 12, 1972. The following members of the board were present: Mayor J. Paul Wilson and Commissioner Avery T. Cashion, Jr. Commissioner Zeb V. Dalton was absent. Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney, was present.

Mayor J. Paul Wilson called the meeting to order and the Clerk read the minutes of the regular meeting held on August 8, 1972. The minutes were approved as written.

Mr. J. C. Lepps, resident of Lake Lure, was recognized and asked that the road leading to his property be examined to determine whether it can be put in better condition. He was advised by Mayor Wilson that such an examination would be made.

Mr. Harvey Gosnell, owner of property on Thomas Beach Knowles Road Extension asked that consideration be given to including said road as a part of the street system of the Town of Lake Lure. He advised that four houses are located on this road. Mayor Wilson advised Mr. Gosnell that the surveyor for the Town of Lake Lure would check said road to determine whether it meets the standards to qualify for Powell Bill Funds.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Mayor Wilson, and unanimously adopted the bill submitted by Cecil Bolick, Certified Public Accountant, for the Town of Lake Lure audit for the fiscal year 1971-1972 was approved for payment and the contract submitted by Mr. Bolick for the fiscal year 1972-1973 was approved and accepted.

Mayor Wilson moved, seconded by Commissioner Cashion, that radio equipment be purchased for the Police Department at a cost of approximately \$2,000.00. This motion was unanimously adopted.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Mayor Wilson and unanimously adopted the Clerk was instructed to obtain bids on a new car for the Town of Lake Lure Police Department.


The matter of whether a working foreman should be employed for the Town of Lake Lure maintenance crew was discussed. No decision was made on this matter.


Commissioner Cashion read a letter from Mrs. E. S. Bejster commenting on the necessity for unity and cooperation within the government of the Town of Lake Lure.

Mr. Clyde Flynn was present and asked that it be included in the minutes of this meeting that he objects to language included in the deed from Carolina Mountain Power Corporation to the Town of Lake Lure.

Mr. Flynn also advised the board that unless the Town of Lake Lure would execute a deed to him for the property lying between the 992 and 995 foot contour as said contour lines cross property owned by him which was formerly a part of the J. A. Watkins subdivision, he would institute legal proceedings against the Town of Lake Lure.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:30 P. M.
