OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE - NOVEMBER 20, 1973



Mayor Wilson presided and called the meeting to order. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as written.

Mr. Martin Nesbitt was present and discussed with the board the paving of Cane Creek Drive and the right of way problems connected therewith.

The matter of the expenditure of Revenue Sharing Funds was discussed. Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Dalton, and unanimously adopted the estimated sum of \$13,626.00 of Revenue Sharing Funds was set aside for financial administration purposes.

Commissioner Cashion moved, seconded by Commissioner Dalton, that Number One (1) Tee and Number Three (3) Green of the Lake Lure Golf Course be improved. Motion was unanimously adopted.
