The following members were present: Mayor J. Paul Wilson, Commissioners William O. Keller, Henry E. Rainey and J. Woodrow Price.


The meeting was held after waiver of notice as follows:



Mayor Wilson called the meeting to order to discuss the Sunday sales of beer and wine.


All aspects concerning the Sunday sales, both pro and con, were discussed. Motion was made by Commissioner Keller, seconded by Commissioner Price and the

vote was unanimous to start the sale of beer and wine April 20th at 1:00 p.m. with the proviso should any new problems arise from these sales the Board will recind the ordinance. The clerk was tasked to mail a letter to each merchant informing them of this decision.


Mr. Weeks, Chairman of the ABC Board, informed the Town Board the architects are ready to advertise for bids for the construction of the ABC store. He suggested using one contractor for both the foundation and the building with separate bids for each. The Board agreed to start with the advertising and in addition to the Asheville Citizen suggested placing the ad in the Rutherford County News and the Daily Courier. Mr. Weeks said copies of the plans and specs. will be mailed to the Town office.

The Board reviewed the Showboat lease and the revenue earned by Mr. Lide last year in preparation for its renewal. Motion was made by Commissioner Keller seconded by Commissioner Price to renew for one year and to increase the rental from the present 5% to 10% of the gross receipts. The vote was unanimous.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
