April 30, 1980


A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall April 30, 1980, pursuant to waiver of notice.

The following members were present: Mayor J. Paul Wilson, Commissioners J. Woodrow Price and William Keller.


The meeting was held after waiver of notice as follows:







Mayor Wilson called the meeting to order at 12:00 o'clock noon. The

Board reviewed the Electric Power Facility Budget for 1980-81. The budget included in addition to regular expenditures, funds for replacing the roof on the Power Plant, painting the Searcy house and possibly digging a new well. motion was made by Commissioner Keller, seconded by Commissioner Price to adopt the budget ordinance as presented. The vote was unanimous. A copy is attached to the minutes.


Mayor Wilson read a letter from Dave Lide suggesting a solution for continuing the Showboat operation. Board members and Citizens present agreed the Showboat is an asset to the Town and are in favor of its continuance. Motion was made by Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Keller and the vote was unanimous to accept Mr. Lide's proposition. A copy of the letter is attached to the minutes.

The Lake Lure Volunteer Fire Department ^{is} are planning a 4th of July celebration with a series of "Country" activities. They include flea market, craftshow and sales, greased pig chase, greased pole climb, hose competition between fire department teams, fish supper, square dance and concludes with a fireworks display. They need to accumulate, in contributions, about \$800.00 for this display. After a discussion motion was made by Commissioner Keller, seconded by Commissioner Price to contribute \$400.00 of the revenue earned from the Showboat last year. The vote was unanimous.


Mr. John Cooke, a new resident in Lake Lure, offered to serve on the Lake Lure Zoning Board of Adjustments. Other volunteers are Ted Cashion, Dave Lide, Bob Jones and Tom Cushman. The Board will select two to serve on the Planning Board and two on the Board of Adjustments. This will be for a three year period.

Mr. Womack said he would be forced to close his drug store Sundays due to the motorcycle gangs parking around his place of business. He stated in addition to obscenities directed to his customers and trash, they were heavily armed. As a solution Mayor Wilson suggested road blocks set up at both ends of Town and run a check on everything. This had been done successfully in other Towns.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
