

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C.
APRIL 28, 1981

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Community Building April 28th at 7:45 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor J. Paul Wilson, Commissioners David Bond, Woodrow Price, William Keller, Henry Rainey and Town Attorney Jervis Arledge.

Minutes of a regular meeting held March 24th were read. Motion was made by Commissioner Keller, seconded by Commissioner Rainey they be accepted as read. The vote was unanimous.

Mr. Cunningham was asked by the Board to get the windows repaired at the Community Building and send the bill to the Town.

Minutes of a special meeting held March 26th at the Town Hall concerning bids for repairs to the fire hydrants were read. Commissioner Bond, seconded by Commissioner Price, made a motion they be accepted as read. The vote was unanimous.

There was a discussion to replace temporally two of the existing members of the Board of Adjustments. On advice of Town Attorney no action was taken at this time.

A meeting was set for May 5th at the Town Hall for the purpose of reviewing a proposed ordinance on water safety.

A covenant was presented to the Town Council by Mr. Hicks concerning unruly persons around the mall and beach area, problems caused by the lack of rest room facilities, and litter throughout the Town streets. It urged the council to take appropriate action within thirty days to correct the problem. Before any action could be taken a heated discussion concerning Sunday beer and wine sales began. Citizens felt the Sunday sales were a contributing factor to the unruly crowds and litter. Mr. Cunningham, President of the Civic Club, requested the Town Board recind Sunday sales.


Mayor Wilson called a 10 minute recess.


