

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C.
SEPTEMBER 2, 1983

A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Office September 2, 1983 at 6:00 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Charles Hicks, Commissioners David Bond, Sadye Gruver, Frankie Queen, Woodrow Price and Town Attorney Jervis Arledge.

Motion was made by Commissioner Price, Seconded by Commissioner Gruver to dispense with reading minutes of previous meetings. The vote was unanimous.

Motion was made by Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Gruver a resolution to enter into an agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the rehabilitation of the Island Bridge adopted. The vote was unanimous.

Rev. Michael Boone requested special permission to put a 22' sailboat on the lake. Upon discussion, motion was made by Commissioner Bond, seconded by Commissioner Price to issue a temporary license, beginning after Labor Day and until the lake is lowered. He must remove the existing port-a-john now on the boat. The Board will ask the Water Safety Committee to review the request. The vote was unanimous.

Bids for the purchase of a truck were opened and because no "Bid Bonds" were included, Mayor Hicks instructed the Clerk to reseal the bids, readvertise, and set up another meeting.

Upon motion by Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Bond and a unanimous vote, the Board agreed to extend the sick leave for Town Employee Larry Tate two weeks.

Mr. Walter Rust presented a petition, with 68 names, calling for an election to amend the Town Charter. The proposed amendment would change the form of government from Mayor/Council to Council/Manager. Motion was made by Commissioner Bond, seconded by Commissioner Gruver to adopt the resolution. The vote was unanimous.
