

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE

September 24, 1985

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Community Center on September 24, 1985. Those present were: Mayor Charles F. Hicks, Commissioners Queen, Gruver, Price and Cashion, and Town Attorney Jervis Aledge.

The invocation was delivered by Dave Lide.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gruver, seconded by Commissioner Queen to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of August 23, 1985 as read. The vote was unanimously approved.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Gruver to lower the lake five feet on the first Monday after Thanksgiving, December 2, 1985. The vote was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Gruver made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cashion to appoint Walter Rust as Chairman of the ABC board. The vote was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Gruver reported that this year's intake from the Beach topped \$64,500, bringing the total income for the last four years to almost a quarter of a million dollars.

Steve McKenzie spoke to the meeting requesting support for the United Way effort in Lake Lure. The goal for Lake Lure in 1985 is \$5,000.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Price to adjourn. The motion was unanimously approved.
