

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE

November 26, 1985

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Community Center on Tuesday, November 26, 1985. Those present were: Mayor Charles F. Hicks, Commissioners Queen, Gruver, Price and Cashion and Town Attorney Chris Callahan.

Brandon Dana, Life Scout, led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Hicks introduced Brandon Dana, the scout who will be heading the litter clean-up campaign on the lake, December 7th and 14th. Brandon said the scouts would meet between 9:00 and 10:00 a.m. with trash bags, maps and instructions, and he appealed for all those interested to join them in the clean-up. Especially needed are those with boats.

The bids on the contract for the fire station were opened at 10:00 a.m. on November 14, 1985 in the Lake Lure Community Center. They were as follows:

Commissioner Cashion made the following motion: I move that all bid proposals received by the Town of Lake Lure for the construction of a new Fire Department Building be rejected pursuant to G.S. 143-129 and that the Town of Lake Lure construct said building using force account qualified labor on the permanent payroll of the Town of Lake Lure with the Town being authorized to subcontract for concrete paving, brickwork, electrical, plumbing and roofing work in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 143-135. Commissioner Price seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mayor Hicks called for all parties interested in renting the marina to have their proposals ready to be presented to the Council by the December meeting.

Commissioner Price made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cashion to approve the contract to audit accounts with Bolick, Ruppe and Associates. Motion passed unanimously.
