

REGULAR MEETING OF THE
LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL

May 26, 1987

A regular meeting of the Lake Lure Town Council was held on May 26th, 1987, in the Community Center at 7:30 p.m.

Those present were: Mayor Charles F. Hicks, Commissioners Karr, Michelon, Wildman and Town Attorney Chris Callahan.

Commissioner Karr moved, seconded by Commissioner Wildman to approve as read the minutes of the meetings of April 28, 1987 and May 12, 1987. The motion was approved with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Wildman announced that the Town Charter had been ratified by the North Carolina legislature on May 15, 1987.

Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Karr to retain the registration fee for the November election at \$5.00. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Police Chief Jarvis requested the Town purchase five bullet-proof vests at \$500.00. Commissioner Michelon moved, seconded by Commissioner Karr to authorize the purchase of the five vests at \$500.00 each and to amend the budget accordingly. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Karr to adopt the Sedimentation Control Ordinance. The motion carried with a unanimous vote and the ordinance was adopted as of this date.


Commissioner Michelon moved, seconded by Commissioner Karr to refund \$73.08 to W. Ray Miller for taxes paid in error. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Mr. Newell requested that the Council decide whether to hire a firm to inspect our bridges and submit report to the Department of Transportation, or to contract with the Department of Transportation to employ qualified inspectors. The cost would be divided between the State (80%) and the Town (20%). Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Michelon to contract with the N.C. Department of Transportation. The motion was unanimously adopted.

Commissioner Karr moved, seconded by Commissioner Wildman to adjourn. The motion was unanimously adopted.
