

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL

December 2, 1987

A special meeting of the Lake Lure Town Council was held on December 2nd, 1987, at 4:00 p.m. in the Town Hall in order to hold an executive session to discuss a particular personnel and to conduct any action arising from the session.

Those present were: Mayor Michelon, Commissioners Queen, Wildman and Moirano.

The Town Manager, Normar Newell, tendered his resignation as Town Manager and recommended that he be allowed to continue with the Town as director of engineering services until the end of January. Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano, to accept his resignation as Town Manager, but continue as director of engineering services. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Moirano moved, seconded by Commissioner Queen to enter into executive session in order to discuss a particular personnel. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

After discussion, Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano, to go back into regular session. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Moirano nominated Paul Wilson as acting Town Manager until the search committee finds a new Town Manager. Mr. Wilson is to have the same payscale and whatever benefits are applicable.

After Mr. Wilson was sworn in as Town Manager, motion was made, seconded and approved to adjourn.
