

REGULAR MEETING OF THE LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL

December 22, 1987

The regular meeting of the Lake Lure Town Council was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Community Center on December 22, 1987.

Those present were: Mayor Gene Michelon, Commissioners Hugo Moirano, Frankie Queen, and William Wildman.

Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano to approve the minutes of December 2nd, 1987. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Moirano nominated Jim Hook to the Board of Adjustments for an additional two years. The Council voted unanimously in favor of the nomination.

Sealed bids for the purchase of the Town's 1977 Ford Backhoe were opened on Wednesday, December 9, 1987, at 2:00 p.m. in the Town Hall. The bids were as follows:

Calton Dairy	3,333.33
Charles Pittman	3,001.05
W.L. Rogers	3,110.00

Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Queen to accept the Calton Dairy bid of \$3,333.33. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Moirano moved, seconded by Commissioner Wildman to reduce the annual boat fee for non-property owners to \$75.00 from \$100.00. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano, to refund Alex Krull, \$78.59. The County had released \$27,100 (valuation) from his 1986 taxes. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Commisisoner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano to appropriate \$10,000.00 for the building of extra slips at the marina, the appropriation to be drawn from the miscellaneous account of administration.

Commissioner Moirano moved, seconded by Commissioner Wildman to adopt a Resolution Calling For A Public Hearing on the Question of Non-Conforming Uses. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Motion was made, seconded and unanimously adopted to adjourn.
