

MINUTES OF THE RECESSED REGULAR MEETING
OF THE LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL

June 1, 1988

The recessed meeting of June 1 was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Mayor L. C. (Gene) Michelin.

Priscilla Doyle reported to the Council about the meetings held with Matthew McEnery of the Rutherford Arts Council.

Mayor Michelin suggested that monies be appropriated in the 1988-1989 budget for recreational and cultural activities.

The Council reviewed the Rutherford Arts Council proposal for possible forthcoming events, and the matter was delayed to the next meeting, perhaps on Wednesday, June 8.


The second item on the agenda dealt with a Resolution for a Public Hearing on the proposed rezoning of the westerly side of the lake. After a thorough discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Alex Karr, seconded by Commissioner Frankie Queen, to adopt the resolution. The vote in favor of the resolution was unanimous.

The third item on the agenda dealt with wage and salary matters, as related to the savings from the new Health Plus Plan. A formula was approved by the Commissioners and the Town Manger, and the first portion of the wage and salary increase is scheduled to go into effect in June, 1988.

The final item on the agenda concerned suggestions for improving the golf course and making it a paying proposition for the Town. A report to this effect will be filed with the Council on Wednesday, June 8.

The meeting was recessed at 2:30 p.m., to meet again on Wednesday, June 8, at 9:30 a.m., at the Town Hall.
