

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL

August 8, 1988

A special meeting of the Lake Lure Town Council was called to order at 9:30 a.m. in the Community Center on August 8, 1988.

Those present were: Mayor L. C. Michelon, Commissioners Hugo Moirano, Frankie Queen, and William Wildman.

Those absent were: Commissioner Alex Karr

The first item on the agenda was a discussion of the Subdivision Ordinance. Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano to have the Town Attorney draw up a resolution for a Public Hearing to discuss the Subdivision Ordinance. The motion was 3 to 0 since Commissioner Karr was absent.

The next item of discussion pertained to the 1988 Land Use Study. Mr. Woody Harton of the North Carolina Department of Natural Resources and Community Development spoke at length on the Land Use Study, and presented several maps of Lake Lure prepared by their group. No motions were made.


The next item discussed was long range planning which consisted of the water supply problem, maintenance of the roads, and the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
