RECESSED MEETING OF THE LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL HELD MONDAY, DECEMBER 2, 1991 AT THE LAKE LURE COMMUNITY CENTER AT 2:30 P.M.

Mayor Doyle called the meeting to order at approximately 2:30 p.m. for the purpose of discussing dredging on Lake Lure.

The discussion included information on the Aqua Mog dredging system which had been recommended to Dick Weaver and Paul Wilson by the Corps of Engineers. Bob Washburn, Chairman of the Lake Committee stated that he had seen this particular item advertised in a lake management publication, and he called the factory to get more information.

The Lake Committee presented the following recommendations to the Town Council for their approval:

- a. Construct catch basins.
- b. Prepare spoils areas (clear, construct dikes).
- c. Seek expansion of existing spoils areas from the Corps of Engineers.
- d. Investigate the purchase or lease/purchase of a dredge that could be operated by a town employee.
- e. Ask the Corps of Engineers to validate the selection of the dredge.
- f. Contract with the selected dredging company to operate, maintain and train Town employees during its first month of use.
- g. Transition Town employees from trainees to operators.


The Lake Committee showed a brief video of the Aqua Mog and how it is operated.

The staff was directed to coordinate the approval of the project with the Corp of Engineers. Dick Weaver, of the Lake Committee, agreed to provide staff with draft copies of specifications for the bidding of dredging machinery.

Bob Washburn, Chairman of the Lake Committee, requested that the Council consider a part-time officer for the lake again next year. He felt that the result of a part-time officer this year had worked out well.

With no further items of discussion, Commissioner Bush moved, seconded by Commissioner Lehner, to adjourn. The vote of approval was unanimous.
