

**Fall Leaf Pick-Up** is tentatively scheduled to begin on November 3. The city is divided into quadrants for pick-up. Press releases will be prepared and distributed to the Norwalk Reflector to keep you informed about leaf delays and/or changes in the posted schedule, in addition to being posted on the city's website ([www.norwalkoh.com](http://www.norwalkoh.com)).

**Quad 1—Southwest**

Beginning November 3, 2008  
south of W. Main and west of  
Benedict

**Quad 2—Northeast**

Beginning November 10, 2008  
north of East Main and east of  
Whittlesey

**Quad 3—Southeast**

Beginning November 17, 2008  
south of East Main St. and east  
of Benedict

**Quad 4—Northwest**

Beginning November 24, 2008  
north of West Main St. and west  
of Whittlesey

This schedule could be delayed by bad weather.

Residential Guidelines:

Residents are asked to place leaves on the boulevard, beside the curb, as soon as possible once leaf pickup is announced. Do not wait for your announced week as we may be in your area early.

If the boulevard isn't big enough, leaves should be piled in the yard near the sidewalk. ***Leaves should not be piled on the street or on the sidewalk.*** Do not pile leaves around telephone poles, sign posts, or guide wires.

No brush or foreign matter (including limbs and other yard waste) is to be included with the leaves as it damages and plugs the collection machinery. Leaves can be placed in bags and left at the curb, on the boulevard, for pickup.

Vehicles should be parked off-street when leaf collection is scheduled to take place in your quadrant to allow the machinery to easily maneuver through the quadrant.
