We will be crossing the streets at the intersections in the area of the school, using our Safety Town Big Wheels on the playground/parking lot and doing classroom work on the following subjects: **Traffic lights, stop signs, intersections, bicycle safety, strangers, gun safety, railroads, Police Officers, school buses and general safety on drugs, matches, fire and poison.**

The Norwalk Fire Department will be utilizing the Huron County Firefighters' Association's **Fire Safety House** in their instructions concerning fire prevention and safety. The children will tour the Police Department and Firehouse.

Your child will be provided with everything they need in class. There is no charge for this program. This is our 49th year for Safety Town in Norwalk.
