# Estimated Water & Sewer Tap Service Fees

Effective April 15, 2013

## WATER

- **Standard Residential Water Meter (3/4") with RF unit, on a developed lot** **\$ 234.00**
- **Large Residential Water Meter (1") with RF unit, on a developed lot** **\$ 346.00**  
For larger homes with several restrooms or a sprinkler system.
- **1" Undeveloped tap (on vacant lot) with 3/4" meter & RF unit** **\$ 2,270.00**
- **1" Undeveloped tap (on vacant lot) with 1" meter & RF unit** **\$ 2,390.00**

- \*Prices above are in effect up to 40' from main service line; Over 40' or Cul de sacs may be more.
- \*A meter pit will be needed if the lot is more than 60' from road.
- \*All taps over 1" must go through the City of Norwalk's Public Works Department.
- \*A "WATER ONLY" meter, for irrigation systems, is the same as a meter on a developed lot.

## SEWER Prices are contingent upon the size of sewer line, location, or work to be done.

<b>Sanitary sewer tap fee</b>	<b>8-12" main</b>	<b>\$ 150.00</b>
	<b>&gt;12" main</b>	<b>\$ 250.00</b>

### **Additionally:**

- The City of Norwalk will perform the tap on all existing waterlines (NOT on sewer lines), and on all meter and hydrant relocations;
- Meter relocation cost shall be the same cost as a tap fee;
- Your contractor is required to do traffic control, digging, or boring of the service line;
- The City of Norwalk is responsible for all work in the right of way, and requires 5 days' notice before beginning work;
- Labor charges for City of Norwalk employees may apply.

All charges are subject to change, depending on work to be done.
