Papillion Half Marathon Road Closures

PAPILLION, Nebraska, May 6, 2016 – The Papillion Half Marathon will take participants on a trek through the streets and trails of Papillion on Sunday, May 15. The race begins at 7:30 a.m. on 108th Street near Papillion-La Vista South High School and finishes inside Papillion-La Vista Stadium. The Papillion Recreation Department encourages residents to use caution Sunday morning and watch for runners and spectators throughout Papillion from 7:30 to 11 a.m. Several road closures and areas of limited traffic will be necessary throughout the city during the event:

- **Walnut Creek Recreation Area** will be closed from 6 to 11 a.m. No vehicular traffic will be allowed into or out of the south entrance from Schram Road from 6 to 9 a.m. and the east entrance from 96th Street from 6 to 11 a.m.
- **108th Street from Highway 370 to Schram Road** will be closed from 6 to 9 a.m. Entrance will be allowed only by vendors, spectators and participants of the event.
- **Schram Road between 96th and 108th streets** will be closed from 6 to 9 a.m.
- **96th Street** will be closed both north and south from **Schram Road to Joy Street** from 6 to 9:30 a.m.
- Residents of **Santa Fe Circle** will have restricted access in and out of the cul-de-sac from 7:30 to 11 a.m. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with traffic.
- Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed southbound on **96th Street** in the eastern most lane from **Lincoln Street to Santa Fe Circle** from 7:30 to 11 a.m.
- Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed westbound on **Cornhusker Road between 96th and N. Jackson streets** from 7:30 to 11 a.m.
- **N. Jackson Street between Cornhusker Road and N. Adams Street** will be closed from 7:30 to 11 a.m.
- **N. Adams Street from N. Jackson to First streets** will be closed from 7:30 to 11 a.m.
- **1st Street will be closed from N. Adams to 72nd streets** from 7:30 to 11 a.m.
- **American Parkway from 1st to 72nd streets** will be open to local traffic only from 7:30 to 11 a.m.
- Motor vehicle traffic will only be allowed southbound on **72nd Street** in the eastern most lane from **Cornhusker Road to Halleck Street** from 7:30 to 11 a.m.

Registration is open for the event online at PapillionRaceSeries.com through May 10, and participants can also register May 14 at CHI Health – Midlands Hospital from 4 to 7 p.m. during the pre-race packet pickup and pasta dinner.
