SumTur Amphitheater to Honor Turtscher Family during Upcoming Free Event

PAPILLION, Nebraska, September 17, 2015 – SumTur Amphitheater in Papillion will honor the Turtscher family, one of its key supporters, during a free concert for seniors on Sunday, Sept. 20, from 2 to 4 p.m. The event, which is open to the public, will feature the Jimmy B Orchestra.

Wes and Ruby Turtscher were instrumental in building SumTur Amphitheater, which has become both a community amenity hosting free family events and a professional entertainment venue drawing national talent. Before Wes passed away in March 2014, he and his wife were regular fixtures at many SumTur events, sitting in the same two front-row seats time after time.

At the start of the event, SumTur Amphitheater and the City of Papillion will recognize the Turtscher family's ongoing support for the outdoor community venue by dedicating plaques on the seats where Wes and Ruby regularly sat. The amphitheater also will unveil a subtle rebrand — a new logo capitalizing the "T" in SumTur to help visually acknowledge the combined names of its two key supporters. "Sum" represents Wally and Elaine Sump, and "Tur" represents Wes and Ruby Turtscher.

"We want to thank the Turtschers for their ongoing support, which has helped us to improve the experience here at SumTur," said Doug Huggins, SumTur Amphitheater manager. "We think this is a fitting way to show appreciation for a family that continues to help make our community a better place to live."
