## Police Access To Homebound

One of our volunteers will interview the citizen to make them aware of the program and to obtain specific information. All information will be kept confidential at the Payson Police Department. In the event the citizen is unable to be contacted by telephone after several attempts, the appropriate agency will be dispatched to check on their welfare. Citizens recently released from the hospital who are convalescing and need to be checked up on are encouraged to participate as well. Sign up your neighbor or loved one today so they can be contacted and begin receiving a daily phone call from a friendly **VIP** Volunteer.
