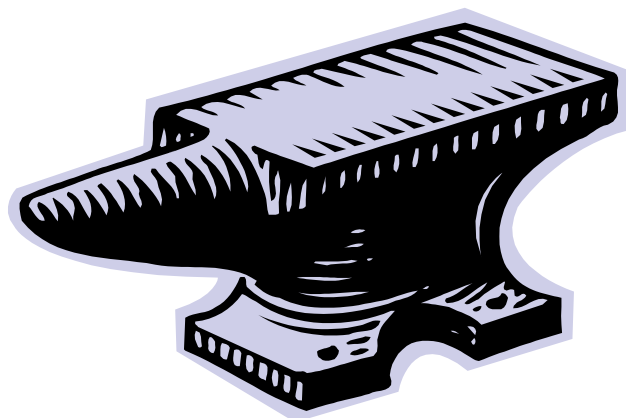

El Primer Paso is a private, nonprofit educational agency founded in 1969. The mission of El Primer Paso is to provide high-quality preschool programs for dual language learners, adult English-language education, and support for affordable, culturally responsive childcare. The agency serves low-to moderate-income families with sliding scale tuition, and private scholarships are available for children in need. The bilingual preschool program is the only one of its kind in the area, accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children--the gold standard in early care and education. Teachers are certified by the NJ Dept. of Education, and the school provides many opportunities for fami

ly involvement in their child's education. Preschool classes are available full-day and half-day, 2-5 days per week during the school year. Aftercare is available as well, and the agency is now offering summer programs. El Primer Paso also offers free English-as-a-Second-Language classes for adults three mornings weekly during the school year. Referrals and training are also available for state-registered, CPR-certified family childcare providers in the area, who care for infants through school-age children in their homes.

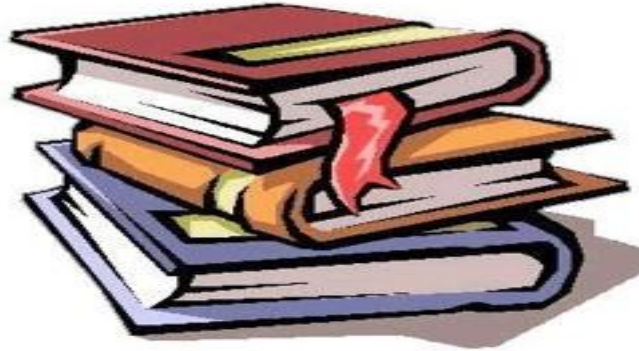

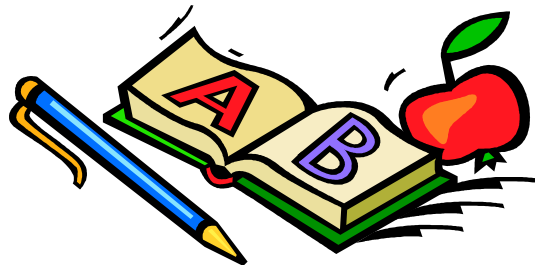
