



**Streamlined Low Voltage Alarm System Permitting**  
**for One and Two Family Residences in the City Of Sarasota**

Due to new statutory requirements the following policy is now in effect for low voltage alarms systems installed in **One and Two family residences only**.

1. We will still continue permitting these type systems in the following way.

Contractors may request permit labels, these are to be considered a reservation for a future permit. These labels will be valid for one year, from October 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> each year. After 12 months the permit label will become null and void.

The permit labels will be \$75.00 dollars plus mandated State fees. On January 1, 2015 the fee will revert to \$55.00 dollars in accordance with State Statue.

The Contractor will be required to post the permit label in a conspicuous place on the premise prior to commencing work.

The Contractor is also required to notify the City Of Sarasota Building Division within 14 days of completing the project by faxing the completed "Uniform Notice of Low Voltage Alarm System project" form and faxing the form to the City Of Sarasota Building Division @ 941-954-4178.

The City reserves the right to randomly inspect the projects for code compliance.

(8) A low voltage alarm system project may be inspected by the local enforcement agency to ensure compliance with applicable codes and standards. If a low-voltage alarm system project fails an inspection, the contractor must take corrective action as necessary to pass inspection.

(9) A municipality, county, district, or other entity of local government may not adopt or maintain in effect an ordinance or rule regarding a low-voltage alarm system project that is inconsistent with the section.

(10) A uniform basic permit label shall not be required for the subsequent maintenance, inspection, or service of an alarm system that was permitted in accordance with this section.

Section 3. The provisions of this act are not intended to impose new or additional licensure requirements on persons licensed in accordance with the applicable provisions of chapter 489 Florida Statutes
