**Residential Alarm Permit Application Instructions**

Each homeowner and/or business owner with an alarm system in the City of Shenandoah is required to obtain a permit. Attached are the permit application and a copy of the City of Shenandoah's alarm ordinance for your reference.

1. An alarm permit application may be obtained at the City of Shenandoah Municipal Complex located at 29955 I-45 North, or by calling the office at (281) 298-5522, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., in which a residential or commercial application will be mailed, faxed or emailed.
2. Complete all questions and answer non applicable questions with N/A. Failure to answer all questions may delay the processing of an application.
3. You may bring or mail the completed application to the Shenandoah Municipal Complex.
4. Upon receiving and reviewing your application, the permit will be processed and mailed within five (5) working days. An alarm permit will be issued for a period of three (3) years, and will be renewed every three (3) years upon submission of an updated application. It will be the responsibility of the permit holder to submit an application prior to the expiration date of the permit.

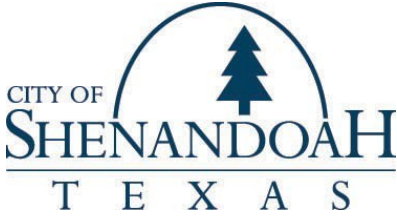

In the case of burglar alarm activation notify the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Communications Center at (936) 760-5800. This number is answered 24 hours a day and will facilitate the response of Shenandoah Police.

In the case of fire alarm activation notify the Montgomery County Fire Communications Center at (281) 292-3333, 24 hours a day.

In the case of medical alarm activation notify the Montgomery County Hospital District Emergency Medical Services Alarm Center at (936) 441-6243, 24 hours a day.

Providing this information to your alarm company will help ensure accurate dispatch and rapid response by the proper emergency services agency for that event.

## Alarm Ordinance

The Shenandoah Alarm Ordinance was enacted by City Council after responding to false alarms. The creation of the ordinance was established with the concept of freeing officers to respond to legitimate calls where needed. As the city continues to grow rapidly the need for such an ordinance grows with it. Each home owner and/or business owner with an alarm system residing in the City is required to obtain a permit. The fees for such permit are on file at City Hall in the City Secretary's office. Place the permit sticker on the front window of your registered site or file and make available to officer upon request.

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### Residential Alarm Permit Fee Schedule

Initial Application Fee .....	\$ No Fee
Renewal Fee (3 years).....	\$ No Fee
False Alarm Fee (beginning with #6) .....	\$75.00 <i>per call/per calendar year</i>
