Two-part essay

Part I: 500-1000 word essay explaining thoughts on volunteerism and the long-term and short-term benefits to the community.

Part II: 250-500 word essay- "Where do you see yourself in 20 years?"

Student must also submit a letter of recommendation (from a school faculty member, coach, church minister, or community leader, etc.) and a college or trade school acceptance letter.
