ORDINANCE NO. O-18-013

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 5, 2018, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS, POSITIONS 1 AND 5, TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SHENANDOAH, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, a General Election was held in the City of Shenandoah, Texas on May 5, 2018, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and City Council Members to the City Council, Position 1 and 5; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly and legally held in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said election have been verified and returned by the proper judges and clerks; and

WHEREAS, it appears that a total of 552 votes were cast in such election; now, therefore BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHENANDOAH, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.
