## **BURGLARY OF HABITATION**

On Wednesday, 16 November 2016 at around 12:30 pm, a resident of the City of Shenandoah returned home from a brief outing and noticed the front door of her home was open, which was not the way she had left it. After entering the house, she and her husband noticed that a window above the kitchen sink had been damaged and had been opened as well. Checking the rest of the home, they realized that they had been burglarized and that a computer and several jewelry items had been stolen. Shenandoah Police Officers arrived at the home within minutes and began speaking with neighbors while other Officers canvassed the residential areas. A neighbor reported to Officers that he witnessed a silver four door sedan parked in front of the home at around noon that was being driven by an unidentified black male as well as a second unidentified male passenger of unknown race. The neighbor did not recognize the males or the vehicle, and only observed the vehicle park in front of the home around the time of the burglary.
