“AFTER-HOURS” CALLS FOR SERVICE

The City of Shenandoah received 137 “after hours” phone calls during August 2016. The Conroe Police Department Communications Center provides non-emergency after-hours dispatching services for the Shenandoah Police Department, which includes relay of information for Public Works issues.

SHENANDOAH PATROLS AND THE WOODLANDS TOWNSHIP ACTIVITIES

During the month of August 2016, Shenandoah officers conducted 295 residential patrols, 703 commercial patrols, and 122 dedicated AOR patrols; logging more than 1,545 patrol hours specific to the City of Shenandoah. Additionally, 370 patrols were performed within the extended service area; logging more than 388 hours of activity specific to The Woodlands Township, as demonstrated by the chart below:

Total time dedicated to The Woodlands Township service: 388 hours / 12:51 hours per day. Agency assists include theft in progress, major accident, wrong-way driver, traffic hazard, robbery in progress, welfare check, and burglary in progress.

The “per day” time is based upon a full 24-hour cycle, or two 12 hour shifts. Each shift is responsible for at least six hours of patrol time within the service agreement area, per shift, barring any critical issues affecting the City of Shenandoah.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS

In August 2016, Shenandoah officers initiated 249 traffic stops while engaged in 237:00 hours of dedicated traffic enforcement activities, as indicated below:

Three cases were assigned to Detective Sergeant Hulse for further investigative action and two cases were completed in the month of August to bring the total active case load to 43 cases. As part of a training initiative to expose patrol level Officers to the requirements of the Criminal Investigations Division for career development, two felony credit card abuse cases were each assigned to Officers Dunlap and Nabors to finalize the investigative efforts in each incident matter.

Two search warrants were composed and presented to the Montgomery County District Attorney’s Office and were further granted issuance in reference to two cellular telephones that were seized incident to the arrest of two individuals charged with possession of controlled substances with intent to deliver. Data retrieved from the telephones will possibly aid in further prosecution of the individuals.

A felony warrant for Assault – Family Violence was issued for the spouse of a female victim that was assaulted at Main Event over his supposed level of intoxication.

A bank bag containing petty cash was stolen from the counter of the Hampton Inn. Video surveillance images captured the suspect and his descriptors while committing the offense. Coincidentally, SPD Patrol Officers were conducting a narcotics investigation in the parking lot of Hampton Inn, and detained the suspect as he approached their incident scene moments later and was found to be in possession of the bank bag. As the theft had not yet been reported and the Officers were unaware of the offense regarding the bag, he was released to his mother while the

narcotics investigation continued. As the Officers were able to obtain a positive identification of the suspect prior to his release, a felony warrant for burglary of a building will be issued for his arrest.

The National Tire and Battery store location was burglarized overnight and the safe from the manager's office was stolen. The safe was later recovered in a parking lot on David Vetter Jr. Boulevard. Reporting Officers were able to collect blood specimens from inside of the safe believed to have been left by the suspects while attempting to gain entry into the safe. The blood specimen was sent to the Texas Department of Public Safety Crime Lab in Houston for processing and possible suspect identification.

Latent finger prints were recovered by the reporting Officer from the exterior door surface of a vehicle that was burglarized in the parking lot of Twin Peaks. The prints were provided to the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Crime Lab for processing.

Four property destruction supplemental reports were completed this month involving cases determined to have been adjudicated appropriately or that had reached the statute of limitations so that Evidence Officer Picone could dispose of the items from the Property Room accordingly.


