“AFTER-HOURS” CALLS FOR SERVICE

The City of Shenandoah received 126 “after hours” phone calls during January 2016. The Conroe Police Department Communications Center provides non-emergency after-hours dispatching services for the Shenandoah Police Department, which includes relay of information for Public Works issues.

SHENANDOAH PATROLS AND THE WOODLANDS TOWNSHIP ACTIVITIES

During the month of January 2016, Shenandoah officers conducted 219 residential patrols, 671 commercial patrols, and 133 dedicated AOR patrols; logging more than 1,578 patrol hours specific to the City of Shenandoah. Additionally, 223 patrols were performed within the extended service area; logging more than 345 hours of activity specific to The Woodlands Township, including two assist calls answered directly by Shenandoah Police units as demonstrated by the chart below:

Total time dedicated to The Woodlands Township service: 345 hours / 11:12 hours per day. Agency assists include a disturbance in progress, felony take-down, and foot pursuit.

The “per day” time is based upon a full 24-hour cycle, or two 12 hour shifts. Each shift is responsible for at least six hours of patrol time within the service agreement area, per shift, barring any critical issues affecting the City of Shenandoah.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS

In January 2016, Shenandoah officers initiated 278 traffic stops while engaged in 305:00 hours of dedicated traffic enforcement activities, as indicated below:

In January, nine cases were assigned to Detective Sergeant Hulse for further investigative action, bringing the total active case load to thirty three.

Latent prints collected during the investigation of a burglary of a motor vehicle at Babin's were processed by the MCSO Crime Lab and were determined to have no viable fingerprint ridge detail. The case is considered closed pending further investigative leads. Latent finger prints collected during the investigation of separate burglaries of motor vehicles at Babin's and Guadalajara were submitted to the MCSO Crime Lab for further processing. Six separate search warrants were compiled to retrieve data from cellular phones recovered from four burglary suspects, one forgery suspect and one narcotics suspects. The devices were submitted to the MCSO Crime Lab for further processing.

A felony warrant for Theft with Prior Convictions enhancement was granted for a female determined to have committed multiple shoplifting offenses at TJ Maxx over the course of several months. The suspect had a total of 9 prior convictions for various theft offenses.

A male had \$30K in U.S. currency stolen during the burglary of his motor vehicle at Guadalajara. An individual contacted the victim and advised him that they knew who the suspect was. Contact was been made with the individual who declined to provide a written statement regarding the suspect. After conferring with the Montgomery County District Attorney's Office, probable cause could not be developed as no specific details were provided by the suspect that eluded to his culpability. The case is considered inactive at this time as the suspect is still a viable investigative lead.

Multiple felony Credit Card Abuse and Forgery charges were developed regarding a male using stolen credit cards to rent a room at America's Best Value Inn and Suites. Multiple mail items determined to have been stolen from several apartment complexes were released to the U.S. Postal Inspection Service for pursuance of federal charges. After conferring with the Montgomery County District Attorney's Office, the felony charges associated with our jurisdiction were placed on an inactive status pending disposition of the USPI investigation.

An assault of a nurse by a psychiatric patient was denied by prosecutors due to lack of probable cause in determining the suspect's criminal intent to cause bodily injury.

An interview was conducted with a suspect in a Fail to Stop and Give Information incident in which the suspect fled the scene of the incident and the vehicle was found unoccupied in a neighborhood on Highway 242. Legal counsel for the suspect prevented him from providing a viable statement. The case was transferred to the original reporting officer for further follow-up with eyewitnesses who observed the collision and may be able to positively identify the suspect.

A forensic interview was conducted at Children’s Safe Harbor wherein a 13 year old female reported that her step-father made inappropriate sexual contact with her. Contact was made with legal counsel for the suspect, who advised that his client would not be providing a statement to law enforcement. The case will be presented to the Montgomery County District Attorney’s Office for prosecutorial consideration.


