“AFTER-HOURS” CALLS FOR SERVICE

The City of Shenandoah received 139 “after hours” phone calls during June 2016. The Conroe Police Department Communications Center provides non-emergency after-hours dispatching services for the Shenandoah Police Department, which includes relay of information for Public Works issues.

SHENANDOAH PATROLS AND THE WOODLANDS TOWNSHIP ACTIVITIES

During the month of June 2016, Shenandoah officers conducted 169 residential patrols, 633 commercial patrols, and 98 dedicated AOR patrols; logging more than 1,482 patrol hours specific to the City of Shenandoah. Additionally, 269 patrols were performed within the extended service area; logging more than 460 hours of activity specific to The Woodlands Township, as demonstrated by the chart below:

Total time dedicated to The Woodlands Township service: 460 hours / 15:33 hours per day. Agency assists include possession of controlled substance arrest, public intoxication, welfare check, evading, disturbance in progress, trespasser in progress, and burglary in progress.

Additionally, 10 Shenandoah Police officers participated in crowd control and law enforcement services during the Trump Rally hosted at The Woodlands Waterway Marriott Conference Center.

The “per day” time is based upon a full 24-hour cycle, or two 12 hour shifts. Each shift is responsible for at least six hours of patrol time within the service agreement area, per shift, barring any critical issues affecting the City of Shenandoah.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS

In June 2016, Shenandoah officers initiated 278 traffic stops while engaged in 318:30 hours of dedicated traffic enforcement activities, as indicated below:

Seven cases were assigned to Detective Sergeant Hulse for further investigative action in the month of June to bring the total active case load to forty two cases.

Two separate aggravated robberies occurred in the month of June 2016. The victim in one of the incidents appears to have been followed from a financial banking institution on Sawdust Road, where she had completed a transaction moments before. Three black males with firearms approached her and robbed her of the bank bag and its' contents. The victims in the second robbery incident were employees of a restaurant and were standing at the rear of the establishment on break when two black males with firearms approached them and robbed them of their purses and the contents of their pockets. Although the suspect descriptors are similar in race and modus operandi between the two incidents, the suspect vehicles were not similar and no other affirmative links have been made to the incidents.

A credit card abuse case was initiated in which the ex-boyfriend of the victim used her credit card without her consent to purchase over \$7,000 in merchandise online. Suspect descriptors and identification has been made and a felony warrant will be issued this month.

A burglary of a medical office suite in which a petty cash safe was stolen was investigated resulting in no physical trace evidence or video surveillance images that would assist with prosecuting any individual for the offense. The case will be considered closed at this time.

The theft of a prescription pad from a physician’s office was investigated after it was learned that three separate black males were observed on video surveillance at three separate pharmacies using forged prescriptions from the pad to obtain controlled substances. The males have not been identified as of this date.

Latent fingerprints were recovered from three separate burglaries of motor vehicles reported in the month of June 2016. The prints will be provided to the Montgomery County Sheriff’s Office Crime Lab for examination. Latent prints recovered from the scene of a burglary of a motor vehicle that occurred in January 2016 were examined by Crime Scene Technicians at the MCSO Crime Lab and were determined to not be viable for comparison and entry into AFIS. The incident case will be considered “Inactive” at this time.

Twelve property destruction supplemental reports were completed this month involving cases determined to have been adjudicated appropriately or that had reached the statute of limitations so that Evidence Officer Picone could dispose of the items from the Property Room accordingly.
