“AFTER-HOURS” CALLS FOR SERVICE

The City of Shenandoah received * “after hours” phone calls during September 2016. The Conroe Police Department Communications Center provides non-emergency after-hours dispatching services for the Shenandoah Police Department, which includes relay of information for Public Works issues.

SHENANDOAH PATROLS AND THE WOODLANDS TOWNSHIP ACTIVITIES

During the month of September 2016, Shenandoah officers conducted 315 residential patrols, 632 commercial patrols, and 114 dedicated AOR patrols; logging more than 1,457 patrol hours specific to the City of Shenandoah. Additionally, 337 patrols were performed within the extended service area; logging more than 377 hours of activity specific to The Woodlands Township, as demonstrated by the chart below:

Total time dedicated to The Woodlands Township service: 377 hours / 12:56 hours per day. Agency assists include alarm, suspicious persons, attempt to locate, and evading.

The “per day” time is based upon a full 24-hour cycle, or two 12 hour shifts. Each shift is responsible for at least six hours of patrol time within the service agreement area, per shift, barring any critical issues affecting the City of Shenandoah.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS

In September 2016, Shenandoah officers initiated 284 traffic stops while engaged in 291:00 hours of dedicated traffic enforcement activities, as indicated below:

Six cases were assigned to Detective Sergeant Hulse for further investigative action and three cases were completed in the month of September to bring the total active case load to forty six cases. As part of a training initiative to expose patrol level Officers to the requirements of the Criminal Investigations Division for career development, Officer Nabors was assigned a sexual assault case that occurred at the Holiday Inn on 05 September 2016. Functioning as Lead Investigator, Officer Nabors met with all parties involved, collected video and statement evidence and successfully presented a felony affidavit to the Montgomery County District Attorney's Office for review. After conferring with Intake Prosecutors, the determination was made to forward the case to the Chief Prosecutor for further consideration. Following her review of the case material, the case will either be accepted for warrant, denied for lack of probable cause or presented to a Grand Jury for prosecutorial decision.

A felony Burglary of a Building affidavit was presented by Detective Sergeant Hulse and an arrest warrant granted for a male that was determined to have entered the Hampton Inn to steal the petty cash bag from the front counter.

A felony Aggravated Assault affidavit was presented by Detective Sergeant Hulse and an arrest warrant was granted for a male determined to have instigated the gang-style physical assault of another male that resulted in significant injury to the victim. Successful prosecution of the suspect will lead to charges being brought against at least three other suspected involved in the assault.

Two black males were observed by Shenandoah residents to be attempting to burglarize a home on Pine Hill Drive by breaking several windows on the rear of the home. The males fled the scene before responding Officers arrived and were not successful in gaining entry into the home. Blood swabs were recovered by the reporting Officer from the exterior glass surfaces of the residence and were provided to the Texas Department of Public Safety Crime Lab for processing and possible identification.

A residence was reported to have been burglarized by the former tenants of the homeowner. Upon their eviction, the homeowner inspected the garage and found that several miscellaneous hand tools had been taken without his permission over the course of several days. Contact was made with the former tenants, who denied knowledge of the hand tools. As there is no possible way to develop probable cause for an arrest, the case is considered closed pending further investigative leads.

Two Forgery reports and one Forgery arrest occurred at banks along the Research Forest corridor in which suspects are cashing forged and fraudulent checks at the banks using pre-printed checks with stolen bank account information. Early investigation indicates that the suspects are homeless or transient males that are being paid to complete the fraudulent transactions by an unidentified individual or organization. AOR Officers have been notified of the criminal activity and have made contact with bank representatives in their respective AOR's.
