

Commission Meeting Called to Order:

Chairman Doug Gordon called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in Conference Room B at Skokie Village Hall.

I. Welcome

Chair Gordon welcomed all Commissioners.

II. Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the February 24, 2015 meeting were approved as written.

III. Chair Update; Programming

Chair Gordon discussed the addition of new technology informational topics to a proposed September or October public event. In addition to public safety topics, the Commission discussed additional sessions that could act as supplemental or stand alone sessions:

- 3D printing demonstration event; Evan Jones Thorne volunteered to reach out to 3D printing vendors to gauge interest in participating.
- Cable company demonstration event; representatives from local cable companies to provide current information about available services.
- "Over The Top" information event; description of products, services, and techniques to obtain informational and entertainment content from the internet.

- Net Neutrality/Telecom Legislation information event; Stu Chapman and Adam Simon suggested as potential speakers.
- AARP tablet training program; Peter Vadopalas will follow up with AARP to coordinate a site visit and scheduling discussion.
- Citizens Utility Board (CUB); plan for a Fall event and determine if additional services might be made available by CUB.
