Pricing for the replacement of one (1) full-size crew cab pick-up truck was obtained through the State of Illinois Joint Purchasing Program.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the award for one (1) full-size crew cab pick-up truck be made to Landmark Ford Inc., Springfield, IL, in the amount of \$ 28,559.00

Comments:

The 2010 CIP budget includes funding for the procurement of one full-size crew cab pick-up truck. The new vehicle will replace the existing 2001 model, used on a daily basis by the Street and Alley Division. The current 2001 model has undergone suspension and driveline problems and will have accrued in excess of 60,000 miles by the time it is replaced. As a result of wear and tear, transportation of landscaping equipment, and usage for field inspections and asphalt maintenance, the driveline and suspension systems of the existing model are now dilapidated. The retired vehicle will be disposed of at the

Northwest Municipal Auction. The new vehicle will be low-emission certified to maintain compliance with the Clean Fuel Fleet Program. The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Landmark Ford Inc. The new unit will be a 2010 Ford F-250 Crew Cab.
