Pricing for the replacement of two (2) pick-up trucks with plows was obtained through the State of Illinois Joint Purchasing Program.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the award for two (2) full-sized pick-up trucks with attached plows be made to Bob Ridings Inc., Taylorville, IL, in the amount of \$ 53,765.00

Comments:

The 2010 CIP budget includes funding for the procurement of two (2) full size pick-up trucks. The new vehicles will replace existing 2000 and 2002 models, used daily by the Street and Alley Division. The current 2000 model has undergone suspension problems and will have accrued in excess of 50,000 miles by the time it is replaced. The current 2002 vehicle has undergone transmission problems and will have accrued in excess of 70,000 miles by the time it is replaced. As a result of wear and tear, plowing operations, transportation of equipment, and usage for field inspections, the driveline and suspension systems of the existing models are now dilapidated. The cost of the two (2) pick-up trucks also includes the cost of the plow attachment and operating mechanism. The

retired vehicles will be disposed of at the Northwest Municipal Auction. The new vehicles are low-emission and FLEX-Fuel certified to maintain compliance with the Clean Fuel Fleet Program. The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Bob Ridings Inc. The new units will be 2010 Ford F-250's.
