


Pricing for the replacement of 5 (five) full size sedans was obtained through the State of Illinois Joint Purchasing Program.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the award for five (5) Chevrolet Impalas be made to Green Chevrolet Inc, Jacksonville, IL, in the amount of \$103,464.29

Comments:

At the recommendation of the Automotive Superintendent, the new vehicles will replace three (3) existing Police Investigation vehicles and two (2) Fire Department vehicles with aggregate mileages between 70,000 and 80,000 miles, which are consistent with Village

vehicle replacement and maintenance policy. The new vehicles will be equipped with required emergency lighting and other equipment to assist in field operations. These vehicles are low emission and Flex- Fuel certified to maintain compliance with the Clean Fuel Fleet Program. The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions through the State of Illinois contracts. The new units will be 2011 Chevrolet Impalas. This year's State of Illinois contract pricing was compared to other groups and individual pricing for vehicles. Staff is confident that this is the best value available to the Village. The retired vehicles will be disposed of through the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction.
