





Recommendation:
It is recommended that the award for one (1) Ford Expedition be made to Landmark Ford, Springfield, IL, in the amount of \$ 27,049.00

Comments:
The FY2011 CIP budget provides funding for replacement of a Fire Department vehicle. The existing unit is a 1999 Ford Taurus and will have accrued in excess of 70,000 miles at the time of replacement. The unit is badly worn on the interior from constant use. As a result of wear and tear, transportation of equipment, on scene idle time, Fire Department inspections and Fire Prevention Awareness programs, the driveline, suspension and exterior of the existing model are fatigued and rusted.

The new vehicle will be equipped with required emergency lighting and equipment to assist in field operations. The new vehicle is low emission and Flex-Fuel certified to maintain compliance with the Clean Fuel Fleet Program. The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Landmark Ford. The new unit will be a 2010 Ford

Expedition. The retired vehicle will be disposed of through the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction.
