

Recommendation:

It is recommended that a contract for the purchase of (2) Two Ford Sport Utility Vehicles be awarded to Currie Motors, Frankfort, IL., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in the amount of 58,913.00

Comments:

The FY 2015 Capital Improvements Program includes funding for the replacement of two (2) Sport Utility Vehicles.

At the recommendation of the Automotive Supervisor, the new vehicles will replace the Fire Chief's and a Public Works Supervisor's existing vehicles. The Public Works Supervisor's current vehicle is a 2006 model year with 62,000 miles. The body and

undercarriage are extremely rusted due to road salt and de-icing chemical exposure. The Fire Chief's current vehicle is a 2010 and will remain in the fire fleet. A 2004 Fire Prevention vehicle with in excess of 90,000 miles will be removed in lieu of the replaced vehicle and sold at the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction along with the replaced Public Works Supervisor's vehicle.

The Village has successfully dealt with Currie Motors for vehicles in the past.
