SUBJECT: Request to Sell Surplus Vehicles and Equipment (Agenda Item)

The following vehicles and equipment have either recently been replaced or are being removed from the fleet. The Northwest Municipal Conference has scheduled a vehicle and equipment auction for October 14, 2014. In order to allow the Village to participate in the NWMC Auction, formal authority to proceed with the disposition of the following surplus equipment is requested:

Additionally, there are three (3) vehicles that are in such disrepair that they are no longer drivable and the cost to repair the vehicles exceeds the anticipated auction values. These include units (57T), a 1999 Ford Taurus, Vin# 1FAFP5224XG229158; (138T), a 2002 Ford Windstar, Vin# 2FMDA50462BB20378; and (89), a 1998 Plymouth Breeze, Vin# P3EJ46C8WN240629. Formal authority to dispose of these vehicles with a local salvage service is requested.

Authorization to dispose of a fire engine is requested. Unit 110T/E16R is a 1988 Pierce Engine, Vin# 1P9CA02DOJAO40560. This vehicle has been in a backup reserve role

since 2013, and is no longer needed. The engine will be disposed through a fire apparatus broker, which is expected to yield a higher return than other forms of disposal.
