Recommendation:

It is recommended that a contract for the purchase of (2) Vehicles be awarded to Currie Motors, Frankfort, IL, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in the amount of \$48,737

Comments:

The FY 2016 Capital Improvements Program includes funding for the replacement of two (2) Administrative Vehicles.

At the recommendation of the Automotive Supervisor, the new vehicles will replace a Fire Prevention vehicle and a Public Works Administrative vehicle. The Fire Prevention vehicle is a 2005 with in excess of 62,000 miles, and is in poor condition. The Public Works Administrative vehicle that will be replaced is a 2006 model year with 68,000 miles. The unit has had several body repairs over its life and is in a deteriorated condition. The body and undercarriage are extremely rusted due to road salt and de-icing

chemical exposure as well. The retired vehicles will be sold at the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction.

The Village has successfully dealt with Currie Motors for vehicles in the past, and has had no issues or concerns.
