

**Recommendation:**  
It is recommended that the award for one Transit Connect cargo van be made to Currie Motors, Frankfort, IL, in the amount of \$ 22,277.

**Comments:**  
The FY2017 CIP budget provides funding for replacement of one (1) pick-up truck for the Health Department Environmental Division.

The Health Department's Environmental vehicle will be changed from an intermediate pick-up truck to a mid-size cargo van. The change is necessary due to the storage of equipment used for rodent control. The current vehicle is a 2005 Ford Ranger and will have accrued in excess of 60,000 miles at time of replacement. The unit is badly worn on the interior and exterior from daily use.

The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Currie Motors. The new unit will be 2017 Ford Transit Connect Van. The retired vehicle will be disposed of through the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction.
