HOW IT WORKS

- **Complete the Carrier Watch application by contacting the Human Services Division**
- **The designated letter carrier places a Carrier Watch sticker on the resident's mailbox**
- **The Carrier Watch sticker signals the mail carrier to note if mail has not been collected**
- **When mail is not collected after two consecutive days, the Human Services Division is alerted and will contact the resident and/or their emergency contact**
