Recommendation:

It is recommended that the award for one (1) Ford Expedition XL, Incident Command Vehicle to Roesch Ford, Bensenville, IL. in the amount of \$43,722.

Comments:

The FY2017 CIP budget provides funding for replacement of one (1) Incident Command Vehicle, for the Fire Department.

The Fire Department Incident Command Vehicle that will be replaced is currently a 2007 Ford F-350 Van, which is used on multiple types of emergency responses. The current vehicle is in a mechanical state of disrepair and is showing signs of accelerated corrosion due to the exposure of de-icing chemicals.

Some of the remaining funds will be used for out fitting of the vehicle with emergency lights, sirens and radios. The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Roesch Ford, Bensenville, IL. The new unit will be 2017 Ford Expedition 4x4. The retired vehicle will be disposed of through the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction.
