SUBJECT: Purchase of Two Full Size Pick-up Trucks w/plows (Agenda Item)

Pricing for the replacement of two (2) pick-up trucks was obtained through the Northwest Municipal Conference Suburban Purchasing Cooperative.

Recommendation:
It is recommended that the award for two (2) pick-up trucks be made to Currie Motors Frankfort IL, in the amount of \$70,174.

Comments:
The FY2018 CIP budget provides funding for the replacement of two (2) full size pick-up trucks with plows, one for the Street & Alley Division and one for the Tree Maintenance Division. The vehicles that will be replaced are currently 2010 Ford F-250 pick-up trucks. These vehicles are used daily by the Street & Alley and the Tree Maintenance Divisions. The current vehicles will have accrued in excess of 50,000 miles at time of replacement. These units are badly worn on the interior and exterior as a result from plowing operations, transportation of equipment and materials and usage for field inspections. The drivelines and suspension systems are worn. The cost of the two (2) pick-up trucks also includes the cost of the snow plow attachment and the operating mechanism.

The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Currie Motors. The new units will be 2017 Ford F-250 series pick-up trucks. The retired vehicles will be disposed of through the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction.
