Recommendation:

It is recommended that the award for one (1) pick-up truck be made to Currie Motors, Frankfort, IL, in the amount of \$ 36,184.

Comments:

The FY2017 CIP budget provides funding for replacement of one (1) pick-up truck for the Public Works Department Automotive Division.

The Automotive Division Pick-up truck that will be replaced is currently a 2000 Dodge that is used as a service truck to respond to road calls for broken down vehicles. The current vehicle will have accrued in excess of 60,000 miles at the time of replacement and is showing signs of accelerated corrosion due to exposure of de-icing chemicals. The replacement vehicle will be equipped with a service body and lift gate. Remaining funds will be used to purchase a jump starting unit and air compressor for field repairs.

The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Currie Motors, Frankfort, IL. The new unit will be 2017 Ford F series pick-up truck with a service body. The retired vehicle will be disposed of through the Northwest Municipal Conference Auction.
