**SUBJECT: Purchase of One Public Works Street Sweeper (Agenda Item)**

Pricing for the replacement of one (1) street sweeper was obtained through the Northwest Municipal Conference Suburban Purchasing Cooperative.

**Recommendation:**  
It is recommended that the award for one (1) street sweeper be made to Standard Equipment, Chicago, IL, in the amount of \$205,956. This price includes a base price of \$220,956, less the trade-in allowance in the amount of \$15,000 for the street sweeper being replaced.

**Comments:**  
The FY2018 CIP budget provides funding for replacement of one (1) street sweeper for the Public Works Department, Street and Alley Division. The Street Sweeper that will be replaced is a 2007 Elgin Pelican. This sweeper is used daily from spring through fall and will have in excess of 48,000 miles at the time of replacement. Sweepers are mechanically complex pieces of equipment and are constantly exposed to sand and grit in their operating environment, which causes extreme wear. This unit is experiencing component failures due to mechanical systems being worn from use and age.

The Village has successfully dealt with previous acquisitions from Standard Equipment, with no issues or concerns. The new units will be an Elgin Pelican street sweeper.
