Recommendation:

It is recommended that the award be made to Standard Equipment Company, Chicago, IL in the total amount of \$270,542. This price includes a base price of \$273,642, less the trade-in allowance in the amount of \$3,000 for the sewer camera truck being replaced.

Comments:

The FY 2018 CIP includes funding for the replacement of one (1) Sewer Camera Truck (vehicle #182). The sewer camera truck being replaced is twenty (20) years old and is experiencing problems with the outdated electronic video components. The generator on this truck is failing and parts are no longer available. This truck is used by Public Works personnel for inspecting main line sewers and to determine responsibility for sewer failures.

The Village has purchased equipment from Standard Equipment Company in the past and is satisfied with the equipment.
