


**2017 Sewer Lining Program**

Bids for the above captioned item were advertised and publicly opened on Thursday March 30, 2017 at the Village of Glencoe. As a result of the solicitation, four (4) bids were received.

Budget Amount & Account: **\$ 800,000** FY18 CIP Sewer system rehabilitation

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that a contract in the amount of \$115,438.12 be awarded to **Visu-Sewer of Illinois LLC**, Bridgeview, IL, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. This project was bid as part of a consortium of neighboring municipalities in an effort to reduce unit prices by presenting a larger overall project. The municipalities included in this project are Skokie, Glencoe, Glenview, Northfield, Winnetka, Northbrook, and Kenilworth. Glencoe was the lead agency in administering the bidding and compiling engineering documents for the project. The estimate for this year's work, based on 2016 prices was \$135,682.

**COMMENTS**

This CIP budget line item also includes funds for other sewer projects including cleaning, televising, and point repairs.

The purpose of this project is to utilize Cured-In-Place Pipe technology to rehabilitate over 2,400 feet of sewer lines. This type of work does not require open trenching existing right-of-way and is completed at a significantly faster rate than typical sewer replacements. Many of these locations were identified through our sewer cleaning and televising program. The exact locations are listed below and a map is attached.

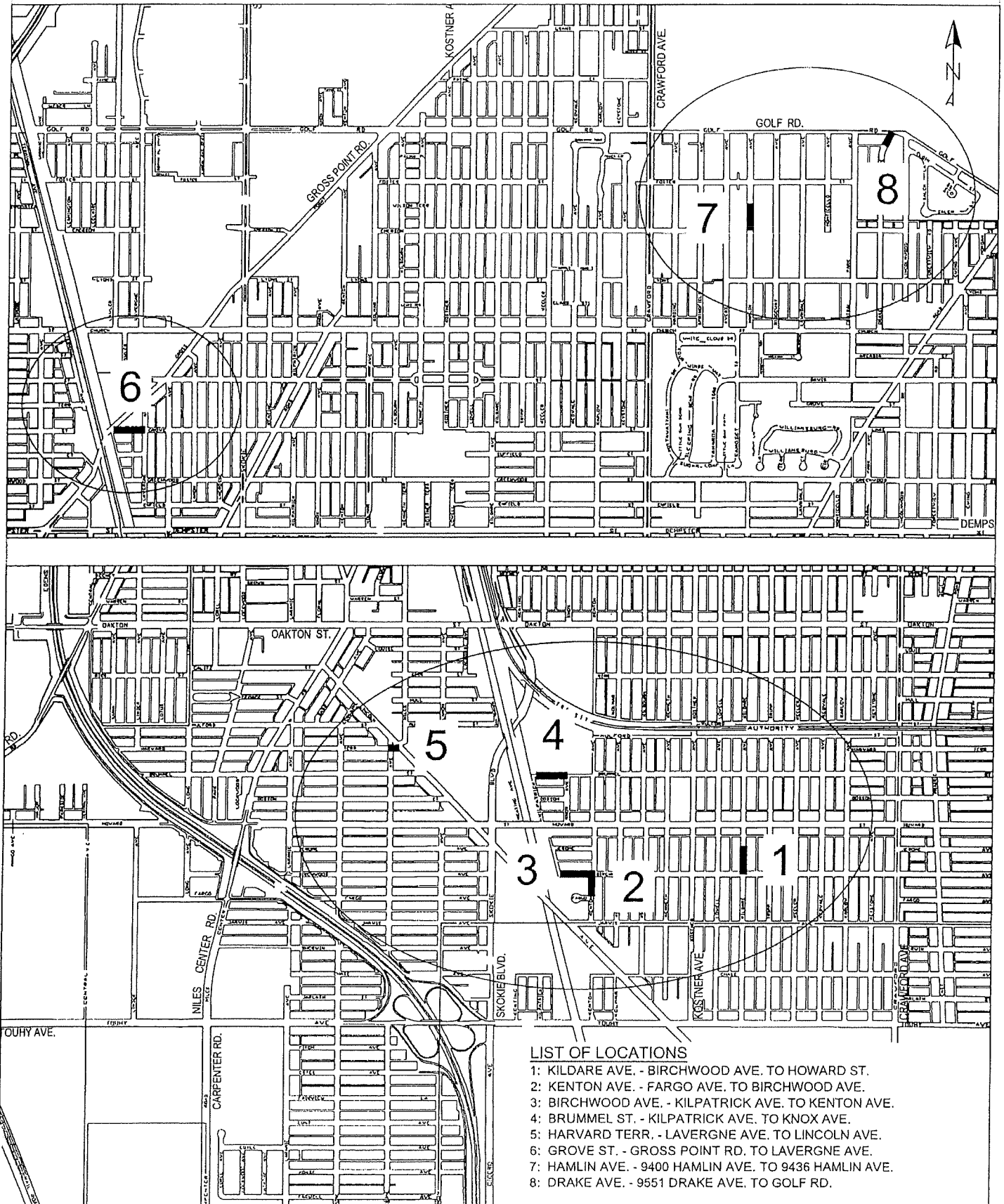
Kildare Avenue.....	Birchwood Avenue to Howard Street
